### **Workshop. Plan of day session.**

The workshops are for 10 -15 people.

### **Title. Creating new futures.**

We want you to imagine your future, the future of the planet, the future of politics, the future of the city. We want you to imagine changing the world, your city, yourself. The Binary Graffiti Club workshop to find out what future scenarios the young would like to see and be involved in. The workshops are geared to finding some answers to this question. The result will be turned into a manifesto and graffiti art.

### **Workshop. Scheme Of Work and Outline**

Working in small groups you will be encouraged to think and come up with ideas based on certain political scenarios ie; what three things would I do if I was the prime minister? The workshop will be set up with expert speakers and facilitated to inspire young people to share their feeling about the world and the way they see it.

**The Outputs.** The text based answers are turned into graffiti (art) and presented in the manifesto online and in the gallery exhibition.

## **Workshop Session 1.**

### **Introduction to group.**

Everyone wears the hoodies and we start by putting them on . Introduce the general art idea and the purpose of the project. What is binary and what we are doing. IE what people want and need from politics. Creating Ideas for social change. **10 mins**

### **Opinions.**

New political futures and how it affects us. What do we want. Talk ideas in politics. This consists of invited speakers to introduce a range of current political agendas) **30 mins**

### **Group work.**

Chaired by a compere to get the views of the groups and start a discussion about what we have just heard and their relative hopes and dreams. The compere will draw focus on the artwork and the manifestation of the idea into graffiti ie to let the people be heard. Making politics that is by the people and for the people **10 mins**

Split into groups of four. Group will evolve ideas in small groups and be given pens and paper for brainstorming ideas connected with a series of questions **5 mins**

What do you want, what don't you like.

1 How you feel about politics . (range of answers) ie your world view?

2 How do you see your future as it is now?

3 What would you like your future to be as an ideal ?

4 How do you make it happen. ?

(relating to climate / economic/ housing/ happiness/ wellbeing /?)

After each of these brainstorming sessions will produce a larger master chart. **60 mins**

### **Conclusion**

Show how the text is made into binary and present the option to carry on for another two hours to make the graffiti in the afternoon. Finally can you please do the online questionnaire **5 mins**
